[Answer from TEPCO]

TEPCO shows a contractor the contents of work of construction, and decides a contractor by bid. A safety control and health care administration are performed on a contractor's responsibility. Implementation of construction is performed on a contractor's responsibility and TEPCO performs only construction supervision.

[Comment from adviser]

The answer from TEPCO described above was replied to the Secretary of the NSC (Nuclear Safety Commission) very early. Because it is only the explanation from a view point of the contract and the bidding, we re-requested TEPCO to give the appropriate answer. However, until today (early July, 2012), we have not received the revised answer from TEPCO.

Based on the previous answer from TEPCO, the adviser suggests to use the following definition.

The workers who do not belong to the TEPCO but belongs to the companies those establishing a contractual relationship with TEPCO. These companies are decided by the bid and during the normal operation, the employers are mainly engaged in and cooperate with the duties in the broad area of the nuclear electricity generation. In order to evaluate personal exposure of contract workers, TEPCO prepared personal dosimeters or WBC for contract workers, even though responsibility of personal exposure record is still on the contractors.
