## [Answer from TEPCO]

At the time of the accident, we lacked most of our PDs at one time and had to lend the a small number of PDs to the representatives of the each working groups. Dose from these PDs were all assessed.

Because the inundation caused by the tsunami, approx. 5,000 of the personal dosimeter became unusable and there were only 320 PDs between March 15 and April 1. We conducted representative measurement when the following conditions were fulfilled:

- Low dose for each work
- The workplace environmental dose rate is known
- Low environmental dose incline
- All work group workers are to take a single action

However, we do not grasp the rate how many workers these PDs are represented.
