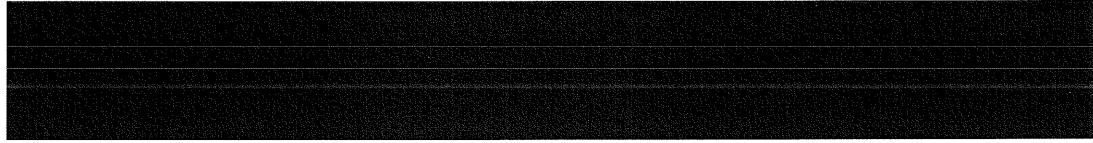


Group D: Request 3.36




[Answer from MHLW: Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare]


For acute syndrome, employers are obliged to report the incident to the chief of Labor Standards Inspection Office by the Ordinance of Prevention of Ionizing Radiation Dangers. Other radiation-induced syndrome will be picked up from the records of medical checkups to be stored in the database of MHLW.

[Comment from adviser]

The data that will be registered on the MHLW Database is limited to the TEPCO workers and the Contractors. The Self-defence forces, Firefighters, Policemen are not included.
